GFAP (“GOOD FOOD AT PIONEER”)

Those who stay at Pioneer enjoy great food, but there are some resources needed to revitalize the kitchen on MacKinnon Island. These kitchen necessities may not be glamorous, but they quietly contribute to making Pioneer the welcoming place that it is.

Target areas include:

- Fridge and cold storage (\$5000)
- Floor, walls and ceiling refinish (\$2000)
- Kitchen cooking/serving equipment (\$3500)
- Electrical - bakery panel and re-wiring (\$1500)
- Stove and oven flues - proper venting (\$2000)

Our \$14, 000 goal this year is represented in tables and place-settings. Each of the 14 tables in the dining hall has 10 place settings, worth \$100 a piece. For every table filled (\$1000), we will color in one more plate in the stack below.
